MAIN POINT

The risen Lord Jesus comes alongside us in our journeys of faith

SCRIPTURE FOCUS

As they talked and discussed these things with each other, Jesus himself came up and walked along with them. (Luke 24:15)

CHAT

Who has a friend they like to spend time with?

We like to spend time with our friends because it makes us feel good and we can share the happy things and the not so happy things that happen to us. Right now we can only spend time with our friends via a video or talking with them on the phone. But, we can still spend time with them. It just looks and feels different.

The two men walking to Emmaus were feeling sad. What turned their sadness into joy? Jesus came alongside two of his followers in their sorrow and brought them joy. He spent time with them, talking with them and listening to them.

Have you experienced Jesus alongside you when times have been difficult? How has he supported you?

e.g. gives us people to talk with so we don't feel so alone

It is good to spend time with other people. Maybe this week we can think of some people who might need a friend to spend time with them. And we need to be creative in how we are going to do this in our current situation of not being able to be physically in someone's presence.
